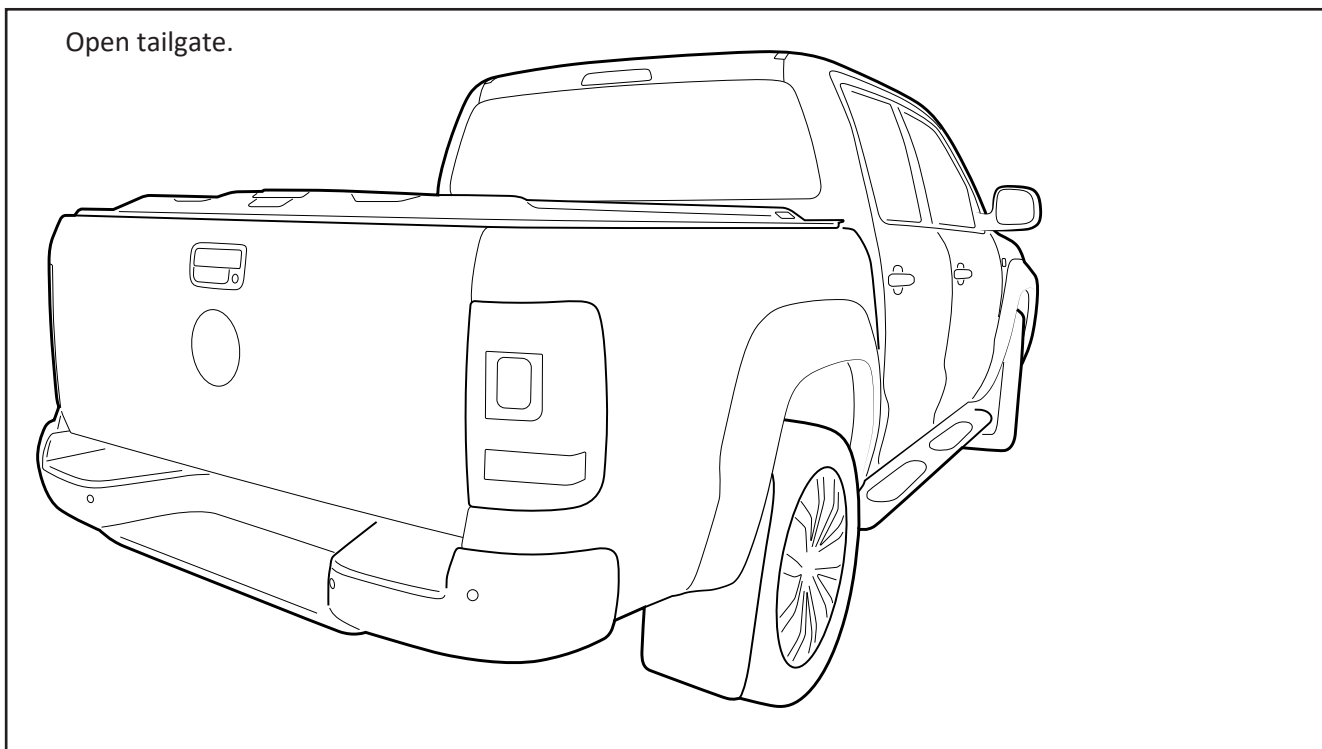

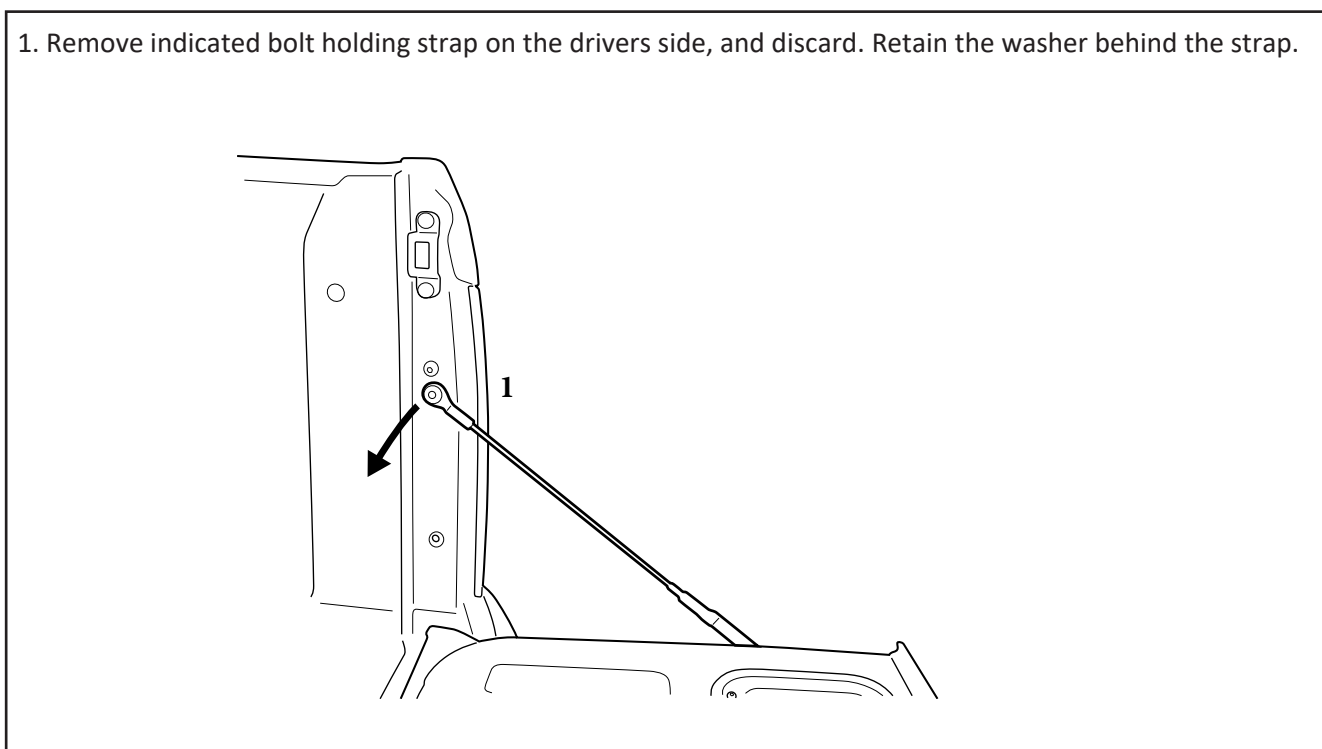
— STEP 1 —

Open tailgate.



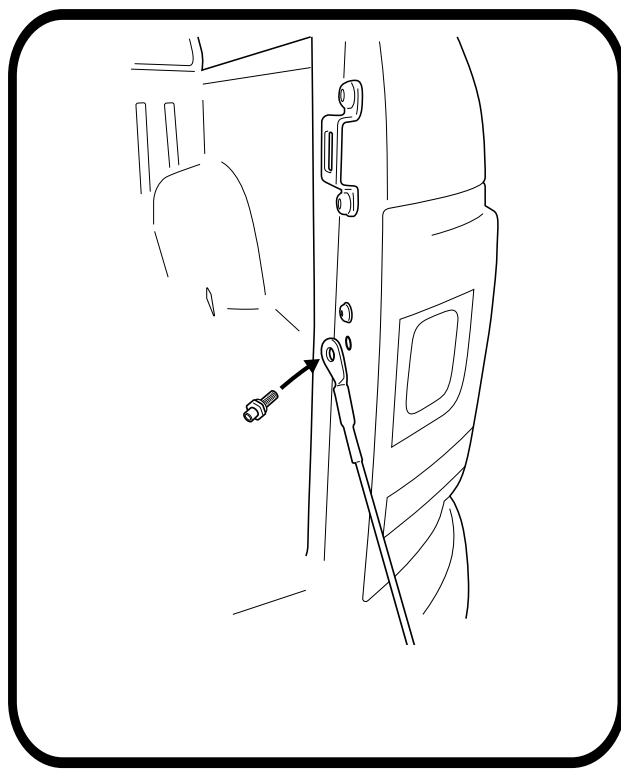
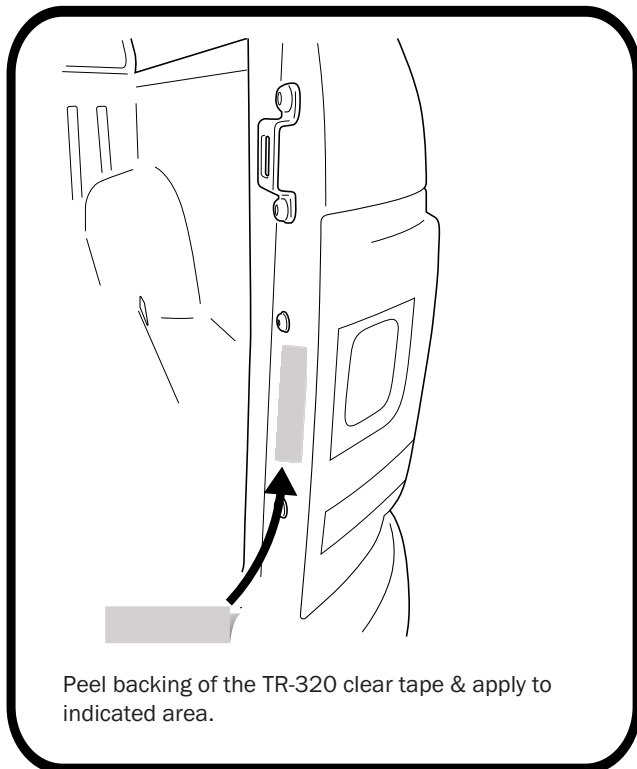
— STEP 2 —

1. Remove indicated bolt holding strap on the drivers side, and discard. Retain the washer behind the strap.



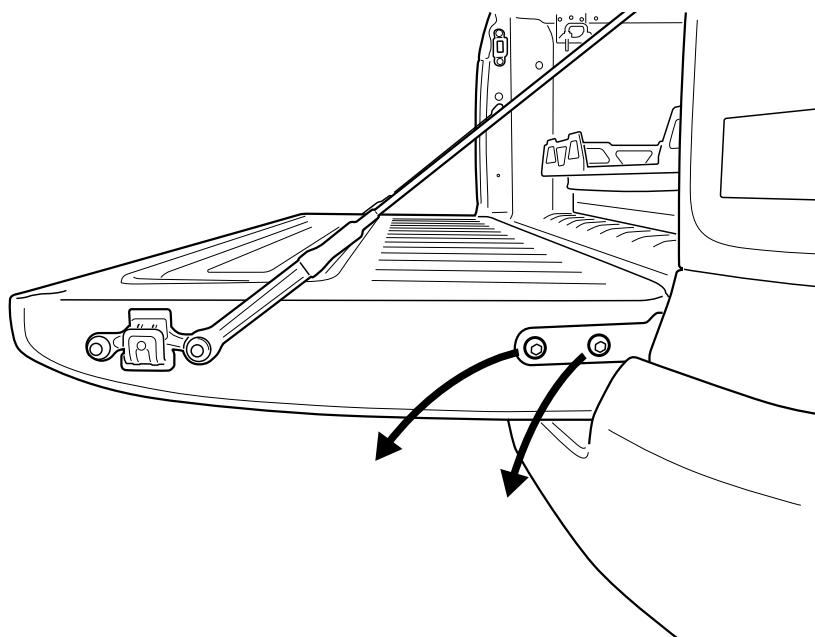
— STEP 3 —

1. Apply clear protection tape (TR-320) as indicated.
2. Feed part number TA-15, (M8 shoulder bolt) through strap, Now tighten.



— STEP 4 —

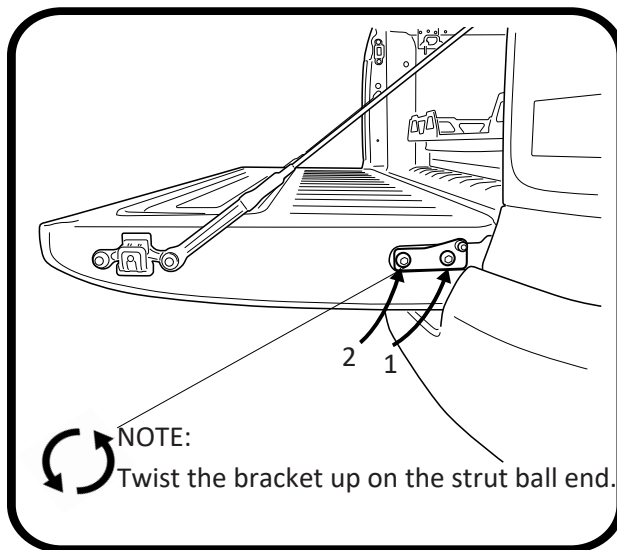
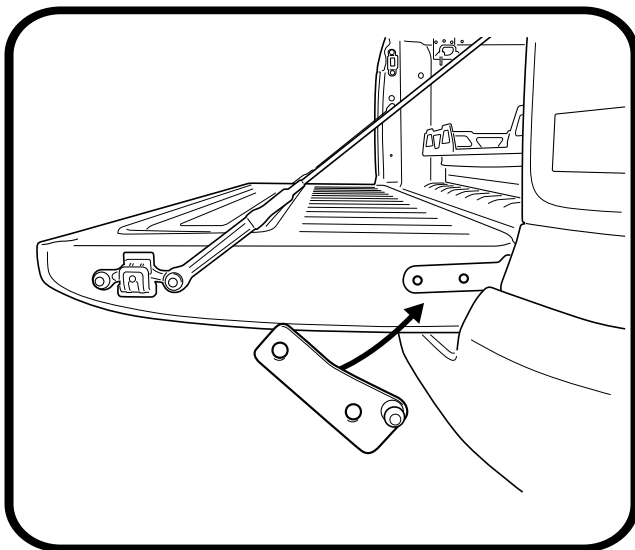
Remove indicated bolts, and retain.



NOTE: Care must be taken not to loose alignment of the tailgate.

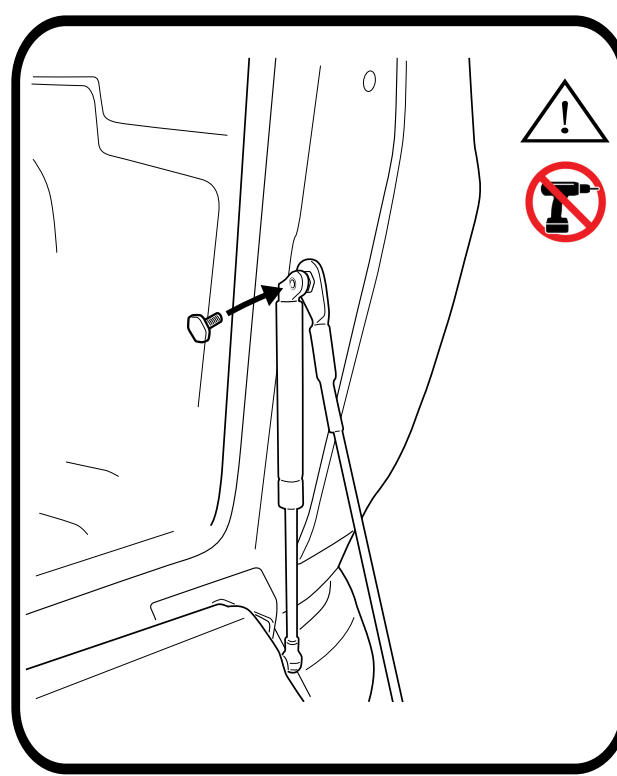
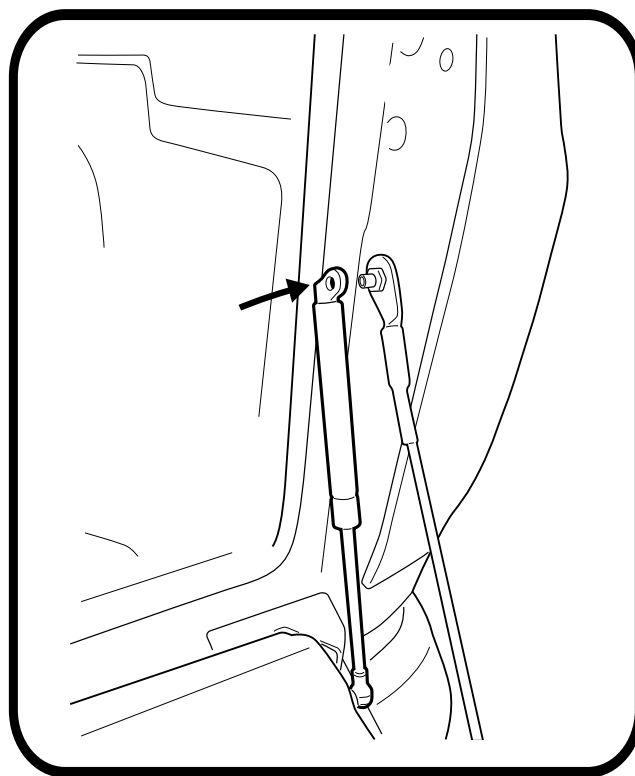
— STEP 5 —

Place bracket TA-10RH over the tailgate hinge and fasten with retained factory bolt to location 1. Use part number 47 M8 bolt provided in the kit.



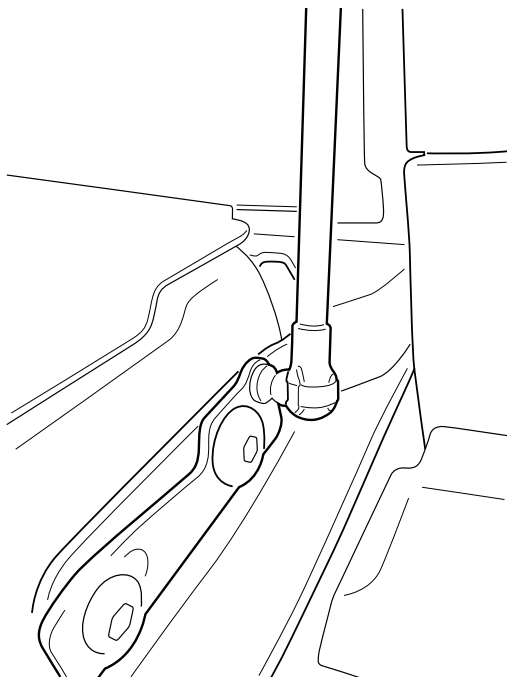
— STEP 6 —

Fit dampening strut, part number KSD cylinder end to the Shoulder of (TA-15) followed by strut locking bolt (TA-16). **NOTE:** TA-16 Should be tighten to 2nm torque, Do not use power tools for this step.



— STEP 7 —

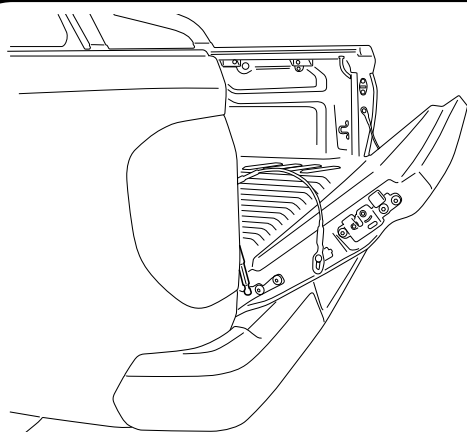
Now fit the shaft end of the strut to the stud ball on the tailgate.



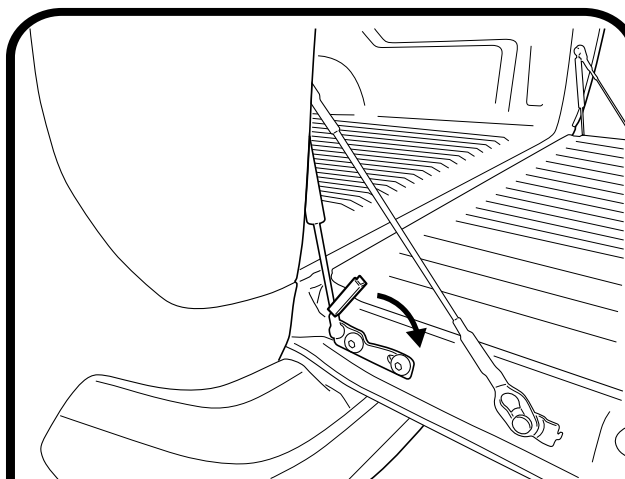
— STEP 8 —

Now repeat all the above steps on the passenger side

NOTE: passenger side tailgate bracket is part number TA-10LH The passenger side Strut has a spacer which will need removing once installed.



**Lift tailgate to reach shaft end of strut,
then push in to position.**
